### "Back To School?"

"In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: "It is more blessed to give than to receive." (Acts 20:35)

I have experienced the truth of this verse of Scripture many times. I would like to invite you to join me in sharing this blessing by providing much needed school supplies to the Cabrillo Elementary School located just west of our church. Last year we formed a partnership with this school when we learned the majority of their students come from low income families. Several of our adults attended this school when they were children.

Therefore, our church has designated funds to help purchase supplies for Cabrillo's staff to utilize in any way they wish. Several other "super shoppers" join me in maximizing every dollar to purchase as many supplies as

possible. We donate supplies to the Cabrillo School throughout the year since their need is ongoing.

The Lord provided several terrific deals the past few weeks. Earlier this week I was able to purchase 60 boxes of Crayola brand crayons (24 to a box) for just 25 cents each from Walmart! They did not have any limit stated on the shelves and no one hassled me about this purchase even though I bought every single box of crayons available on the shelves! I also purchased 40 of the spiral bound notebooks (70 pages each) for just 15 cents each!

Last week I took advantage of an online deal to purchase a number of office supplies from Walgreen's. The BIC "brite liners" (sets of 5 markers each) were on sale for just 49 cents each. This online offer had a \$10 off a purchase of \$40 or more. I was able to buy several sale items that were already reduced and reached a total of barely over \$40. This past week I also purchased a number of special 30 pack mechanical pencils for just 99 cents each from Walgreens.
