Our Sunday school teachers are working hard each Sunday to minister to your children. What a joy they have in teaching them about GOD. As you will read, below are lessons and activities they are currently teaching your child. We invite you to visit any of the classes or stay to observe.

The **Pre-School, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Sunday School** teacher, Lorrie Kimura is teaching her class to pray, share and learn what is in the Bible. They begin their Sunday School class with a prayer. To reinforce the lessons of 'sharing', each child shares with the class their week's experiences and involvements. The children are also reminded of sharing during play time as they share the toys with one another. The class is using The Beginner's Bible to listen and read about Bible stories.

After Thanksgiving, the children started rehearsing for the Christmas Outreach Program that was on December 18. They learned to sing: *Away In the Manager; Go Tell It On the Mountain* and *Little Drummer Boy*.

During Sunday School, they learned about the birth of Jesus, His life and some of the miracles He performed. From The Beginner's Bible, they

learned about *The Beginning, Adam & Eve, Noah's Ark, The Tall Tower called Babel; Abraham and Sarah and their son Isaac* from the book of Genesis.

**3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Sunday School** teacher, Dee Din is teaching the students from the book of Genesis using activities to help the children connect to Jesus. The activities include hands on and verbal participation.

**5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Sunday School** teacher, Mei is co-teaching this class with Meena. They started off the new school year with lessons on the prophets. The students learned about the time period that the prophets delivered messages from God, who they delivered messages to as well as how the messages predicted the birth and work of Jesus. The students are currently on a series about sportsmanship. Once this series is completed, they will be studying the book of John.

Mei and Meena are looking forward to making this a year of fun and growth in learning God's word with the students.

**7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Sunday School** teacher, Joe Yee is teaching the students using the New Testament. Each lesson begins with a prayer followed by a true miracle story occurring in modern times. The students are challenged with a memorization exercise that usually involves a Bible verse. This is followed by the oral reading of selected Bible verses and various activities such as written work, reviews, games, tests, or movies. The class time is closed with a time of prayer.
